

BURN PERMITS REQUIRED FOR ALL SLASH BURNS

Anyone wanting to burn slash in our District **must** have an *Open Burning Permit* from the county where they'll be doing the burn. Another (second) *Open Burning Permit*, issued by the CCCFPD, will also be required before burning is allowed. District permits will only be issued after a pre-approved site inspection has been conducted by the Fire Marshal. NOTE: The CCCFPD permit is valid only when in conjunction with the appropriate county health department Open Burning Permit. County permits may be obtained by contacting the appropriate agency below.

After your permits have been issued to you, you must call the CCCFPD at 303-642-3121 and Boulder County Dispatch at 303-441-4444 before and after each permitted burn. **NO** burning will be permitted without a current permit and at least four (4) inches of snow on the ground at the burn site. In addition, burning is allowed only between 10:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. and all fires must be completely out by 4:00 P.M., with no residual smoke.
